

RESOLUTION 2023-43

Authorizing the Use of General Contingency for Costs to Intervene in the 2023 Madison Gas & Electric Rate Case

Whereas, on June 6, 2023 the Common Council approved Resolution 2023-34 ratifying the City’s intervention in the 2023 Madison Gas & Electric (MG&E) Rate Case Docket #3270-UR-125 before the Public Service Commission; and

Whereas, the City intends to provide testimony to the Public Service Commission in service to the City, Middleton taxpayers, residents, and businesses that could be potentially negatively affected by the elimination of net metering for distributed renewable energy systems as part of MG&E’s rate case; and

Whereas, the City Attorney’s office has prepared an estimated cost for their participation of the rate case intervention of approximately \$30,000 based on 95 hours of work; and

Whereas, there may be additional costs associated with the City’s intervention in the MG&E rate case including contribution toward the cost of expert witness to testify before the PSC; and


Whereas, staff recommends that the Common Council authorize the use of up to \$35,000 of the City’s \$135,349 in 2023 general contingency for costs related to the MG&E rate case intervention.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS: That the City Council hereby authorizes the following budget adjustment and allocation from the 2023 general contingency.


