

RESIDENT/NON-RESIDENT FAQs

Q: Are Town of Middleton, Town of Westport, Village of Waunakee, Village of Cross Plains, City of Verona, City of Madison residents considered residents or non-residents for program registration, facility reservations, memberships?

A: Town of Middleton, Town of Westport, Village of Waunakee, Village of Cross Plains, City of Verona, City of Madison residents are considered non-residents. Even if your mailing address is "Middleton" it does not necessarily mean you are a city resident.

Q: We live within the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District, why are we not considered residents?

A: The Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District is funded by all the residents that live within that district. The City of Middleton Parks & Recreation Department is only funded by the City of Middleton residents, meaning those residents that live within the district, but not within the City of Middleton would be considered non-residents.

Q: Who do I talk to about reconsidering the resident and non-resident fee structure?

A: It would be best to reach out to your local municipal elected officials (i.e. City of Middleton residents should reach out to City of Middleton elected officials and Town of Middleton residents should reach out to Town of Middleton elected officials).

Q: Does this fee apply per participant?

A: Yes, the fee structure will apply per participant, per program.
