Unless such approval has been granted by the Landmarks Commission, the Building Inspector shall not issue any permit for any such work.

In the case of a landmark, will the proposed work be contrary to the Standards for Rehabilitation as noted in Sec.2.35(5)(b)1 of the City ordinance and [36 CFR 68.3](#) Standards for preservation, rehabilitation, restoration, and reconstruction?
