

# MGE Electric Upgrade

## Project Update



Madison Gas and Electric (MGE) has been making progress upgrading the electric system in the City of Middleton. The project is designed to enhance service reliability, reduce outages, minimize tree trimming, and to prepare the area for the next generation of power delivery.

This work includes replacing aging facilities and installing some new underground electric lines throughout the city, as well as replacing or removing existing overhead power lines.

### What's new

The project is currently approximately 60 percent complete, and construction activities are ongoing. The work is expected to be completed this summer.

MGE and its digging contractor, Meade, are installing new electric lines in and around these remaining areas south of University Avenue:

- Maple Street
- Cooper Avenue
- Anderson Avenue
- South Avenue
- Mayflower Drive
- Orchid Lane
- Maple Court
- Park Street

The crews will then focus north of University Avenue, including areas along Mendota Avenue, Lakeview Boulevard, N Gateway Street and Branch Street.

After construction, our crews will promptly restore any disturbed areas to their preexisting state. You also may see Hooper crews trimming trees for lines that will be rebuilt overhead to accommodate taller poles.

### Easement requests

Thank you to those residents who have signed easements, allowing this upgrade to move forward. Not all properties require an easement; the need for an easement is dependent on the location of the property and how it may be impacted by the project.
