

**RESOLUTION 2025-52**  
**Authorizing the Use of General Contingency Funds for Painting of the  
 Crosswalk at the University Avenue / Cayuga Court Intersection**

**Whereas**, in 2025 the City of Middleton funded the Cayuga Connector project using funds from Tax Increment Financing District #3 (TID 3); and

**Whereas**, staff recommend restriping a faded crosswalk on the eastern leg of the University Avenue / Cayuga Court intersection due to complaints received from bicyclists about poor pavement markings; and

**Whereas**, the City has received a cost estimate for the payment markings in the amount of \$13,812 and approval from the Wisconsin Department of Transport to proceed; and

**Whereas**, the TID 3 expenditure period ended on September 29, 2025 and the City is no longer able to initiate new expenditures funded by the TID; and


**Whereas**, staff recommends that the Common Council authorize the use of up to \$15,000 of the City's \$100,000 in 2025 general contingency funds for pavement markings at the University Avenue / Cayuga Court Intersection.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the following budget adjustment and allocation from the 2025 general contingency.
