

Cart Placement

Carts must be set curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. (Ord. 6.04)

- Carts may be set out up to 12 hours prior to collection day.
- Carts must be removed from the street right-of-way within 12 hours after collection.

Place carts about 2' behind the curb.

- Handle (lid hinge) should be toward the house.
- The arrow on the lid should point at the street.
- Keep carts clear from sidewalks.

Place carts at least 4' clear of other carts, cars, trees, mailboxes, poles, etc.

- Drivers can't get out to move carts for access by mechanical arm.



Well done!

Do not place carts in the street.

- Keep gutters clear for drainage, including for snow melt in winter.
- Prevent causing a hazard for bicycling, driving and parking – with potential liability.
- Allow efficient street sweeping, leaf & brush collection, and snow plowing.
- Avoid the hassle and expense of cart damage.

In winter, do not place carts on a snowbank or in the street.

- Continue to place carts in your driveway apron, or in a shoveled area on the terrace.

Carts are the property of Pellitteri Waste Systems.

You are responsible for loss or damage to the carts, other than normal wear.
