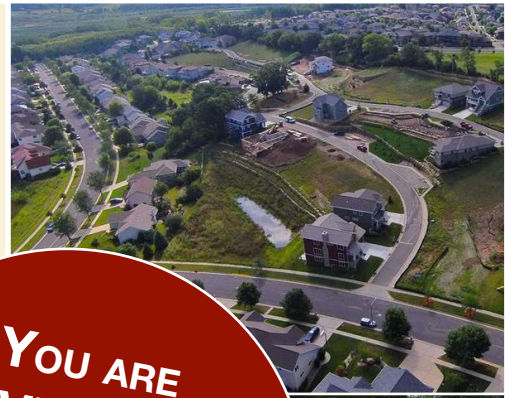

What is a Zoning?

Over the next year, the City of Middleton will be working on a full rewrite of the City's Zoning Ordinance and the creation of a new Zoning Map. A Zoning Ordinance is a set of rules that a local government adopts to regulate the use of land, particularly when new development is proposed. It also includes rules for density, quality and design of development, landscaping, signage, and more. These rules are specific to individual Zoning Districts (single-family, commercial, industrial, etc.) that are applied to all land in the City and shown on the Zoning Map.
